- ➤ Northwest Human Services: CEO of 35 years retiring. Announcement coming by the end of this week. There's been approval for upgrades at the Total Health Community Clinic. The Total Health Community Clinic is onboarding a new Community Health Worker (CHW).
- ➤ <u>Homeshare Oregon</u>: #1 goal is to make home sharing normal. New Executive Director, Savenia Falquist. Homeshare is currently looking to hire a homeshare coordinator. Have helped 450 people find housing in Oregon.
- Church at the Park: Up to 3 families to stay in Dallas site coming for November. Flyer shared with the group on a Dallas Property Blessing. ADU unit will have 3 more families. Monmouth update: Currently a classroom building and will change to 14 individual rooms. Over half of the beds are for individuals over the age of 50. Monthly community advisory group next meeting is August 20th. C@TP hired new staff to Staff Manager. Polk County Chaplain hired.
- ➤ <u>Josh Coleman</u>: Starting a housing initiative coalition.
- ➤ <u>Paul Hamalian</u>: West Valley Housing Authority: They are 6 months over allocated on funding received from the federal government. In June they got recognition from HUD about being a great performing local housing authority.
- ➤ Polk County Behavioral Health: Crisis center opening at the Academy Building in Dallas will be much like the Psychiatric Crisis Center (PCC) in Salem.
